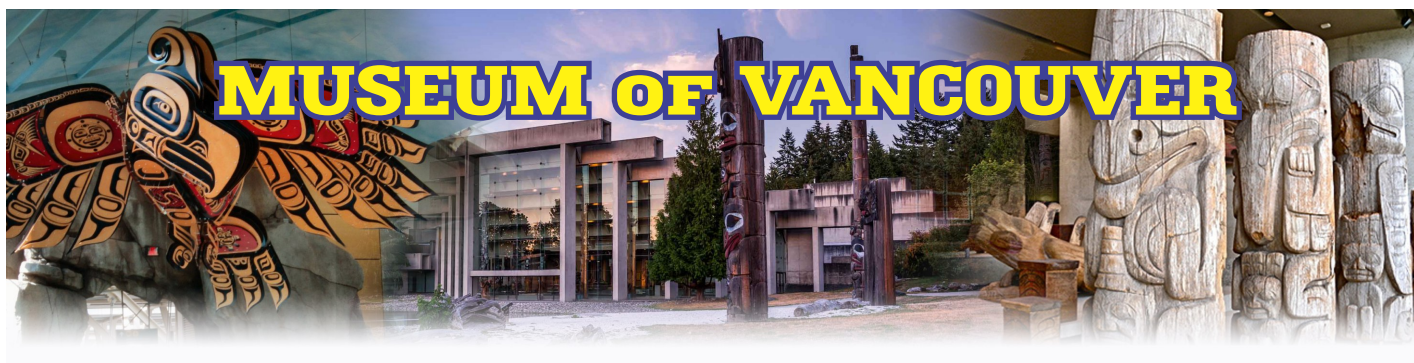


*Burnaby Settlement Workers in Schools (SWIS) invite
